. Wash the Toys (Cleanliness & Hygiene)

- Skill: Personal hygiene, responsibility
- Activity: Kids wash plastic toys with mild soap and water using a sponge or cloth.
- 2. Button the Shirt (Dressing Skills)
 - Skill: Fine motor skills, self-dressing
 - Activity: Give children a shirt or a dressing frame and let them practice buttoning and unbuttoning.
- 3. Sort the Laundry (Color Recognition & Responsibility)
 - Skill: Sorting, decision-making
 - Activity: Let kids help sort clean laundry into piles light/dark colors, socks/shirts, etc.
- 4. Make a Sandwich (Food Skills)
 - Skill: Simple food prep, independence
 - Activity: Kids spread butter or jam on bread using a plastic knife and put together their own sandwich.
- 5. Set the Table (Manners & Routine)
 - Skill: Organization, table manners
 - Activity: Teach children how to place a plate, spoon, and napkin properly for meals using real or play dishes.

Activity Name: *Daddy's Treasure Jar* Objective: To help children create a special "piggy bank" style jar filled with love notes or "reasons why I love Dad."

Material Needed:

- A clean plastic jar or small box (with a lid)
- Colored paper or craft foam (cut into coin shapes or hearts)
- Crayons or markers
- Stickers, washi tape, and decorations
- Label: "Daddy's Treasure Jar" or "Dad, You're My Treasure!"
- Ribbon (optional)

Instructions:

1. Decorate the Jar: Kids decorate the jar or box with stickers, drawings, and a label like "Daddy's Treasure Jar."

- Make the "Coins": Give children pre-cut circles or hearts and help them draw or write simple things like:
 - "I love Dad because he plays with me."
 - "Dad gives me big hugs."
 - "Dad is my superhero!"
- 3. Fill the Jar: Put all the "coins" or hearts inside the jar.
- Gift It with Love: Children present the jar to their dads saying, "This is your jar of treasures—because you're my treasure!"

WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY


"World Environment Day is celebrated every year on 5th June to raise awareness and encourage everyone to help protect and care for our environment."

Activity Name: *Plant a Smile, Grow a Future* **Objective**: To teach children the importance of plants and caring for nature.


B Instructions:

- 1. **Decorate the Pot**: Let children decorate their paper cups with drawings of flowers, the sun, or Earth.
- 2. Fill with Soil: Help them fill the cup halfway with soil.
- 3. **Plant the Seeds**: Let each child gently place 2–3 seeds in the soil and cover them.
- 4. Water Time: Spray a little water on the soil.
- 5. Name the Plant: Use a popsicle stick to write the child's name or their plant's name.
- 6. **Take It Home**: Encourage them to care for their plant every day at home.



1. Introduction to CVC Words: Start by explaining CVC words (like cat, bat, dog and how each letter makes a sound.	g)			
2. Sound it Out: Practice saying the sounds of each letter clearly – beginning, middle, and end.				
3. Create the Book: Let kids create their own flip books by writing and illustra CVC words on each page.	ting			
4. Flip and Read: Practice blending the sounds to read the words aloud.				
5. Decorate and Share: Let children personalize their books with drawings or stickers and share their creations with classmates or family.




