MATHEMATICS

Project Title: The Quadrilateral Property Investigator Flip-Book

In geometry, **quadrilaterals** are four-sided polygons, but each member of this family has a unique "personality" or set of rules. You will create a **multi-layered flip-book**. Each "page" will be slightly longer than the one before it, creating a "tabbed" effect at the bottom where the name of the shape is visible. Each page will feature:

- A physical model of the shape (using craft materials).
- A detailed list of its geometric properties.
- The formulas for its Area and Perimeter.
- On the Cover Page, call it something catchy like-
Quadrilateral Classified: The Investigator's Secret Files. "Use a "Top Secret" or "Detective" theme etc.

Material required

- 6-7 sheets of A4 Cardstock or thick coloured paper (different colours for each shape work best).
- Connectors: A stapler, hole puncher with ribbon, or a spiral binder.
- Modeling: Matchsticks, toothpicks, or colorful drinking straws (to build the shapes).

- Any Decorative material

Size and Dimensions

- Total Size: Approximately 15 cm wide x 21 cm high (A5 size is ideal for a flip-book).
- The "Tab" Effect:
 - Page 1 (Cover): 15 cm x 11 cm
 - Page 2 (Parallelogram): 15 cm x 13 cm
 - Page 3 (Rectangle): 15 cm x 15 cm
 - Page 4 (Rhombus): 15 cm x 17 cm
 - Page 5 (Square): 15 cm x 19 cm
 - Page 6 (Trapezium/Kite): 15 cm x 21 cm

(Note: Each page is 2 cm longer than the previous one so the titles at the bottom are always visible.)
